A pension of \$8.00 a month to begin 1 May 1818 was granted to John Ryon of the township of Amwell in Amsterdam County, New Jersey, age 77.

He would thus have been born in 1741 but the file does not state where.

His affidavit states that in 1778 he enlisted in Captain John Anderson's company in the Fourth Regiment under the command of Colonel Ephraim Martin. He was in the Battle of Monmouth. He served out his enlistment term.

Since the war he resided in the township of Amwell without change or move. He was

in reduced circumstances
by 1818.
