This man filed pension claim in Morgan County, State of Alabama on 28 January 1834 at the age of 77.

Stated he was born 14 April 1755 in Amherst County, Virginia where he resided until the outbreak of the Revolutionary war. He was called to help guard prisoners in Albemarle County Virginia far from the. In 1781 he enlisted in a company under Captain John Gallaway with whom he marched to Richmond where they joined the main army under General Washington and La Fayette until the surrender of Lord Cornwallis. He states that he was at

the Continental secretary at  
York town and at numerous  
small engagements.

After the war he lived  
in South Carolina and then  
moved to Alabama.
